

# JUST "4" FUN

4-Patch  
4-Fabric  
4 Blocks



FINISHED SIZE: 76" x 85"  
FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 4 1/2"

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This quilt is a simple design that lends itself to quick assembly. This design calls for four fabrics although a variety of 5" squares could be used just by sorting them by values into groups of light, medium and dark values.

Fabrics #1, #2 and #3 should be the same color group in 3 values.

Fabric #1 Light background with light print (50" or 1 1/2 yds)

- o Cut 80 - 5" squares

Fabric #2 Medium print (30" or 1 yd)

- o Cut 45 - 5" squares

Fabric #3 Dark Print (2 yds)

- o Cut 45 - 5" squares
- o Cut 12 strips 2 3/4" x WOF

Fabric #4 Muslin (1 yd)

- o Cut 12 strips 2 3/4" x WOF

## MAKE 72 FOUR-PATCH BLOCKS

Strip piece 12 sets of fabric #3 & #4. Press seams toward fabric #3. Cut strips sets into 144 - 2 3/4" 2-block units. Join pairs of these 2-block units to form four-patch blocks. Make 72.

## ASSEMBLY

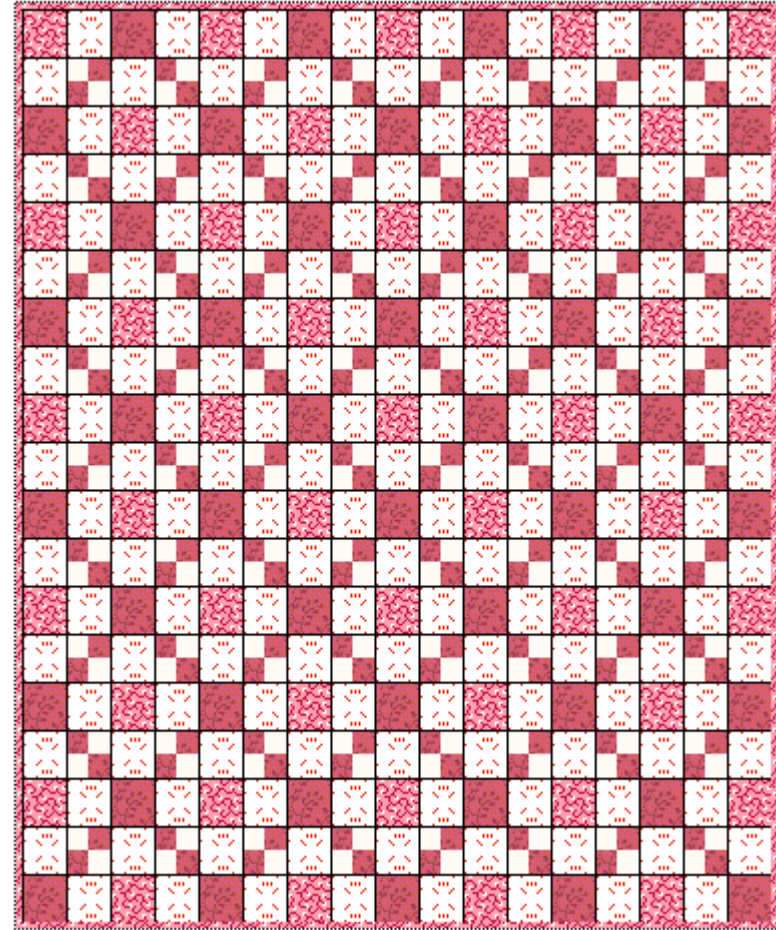
Lay out quilt using diagram as a guide. Label the first block in each row. Join blocks into rows. Press all seams toward fabric #1. Join rows. Press row away from rows with 4-patch blocks.

## STAY-STITCH

I recommend stay-stitching around the perimeter of your quilt 1/4" from the edge to maintain the size integrity of the outer blocks. A walking foot works best for this stitching.

## BINDING

Double fold binding will require 9 strips of fabric, 2 1/2" or 3" wide according to your preference, to be pieced together. Binding will require 3/4 yd fabric.



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
