This is the form I use to gather information about your quilt top and to provide an estimate for the quilting. Please feel free to print and use this form to attach to your quilt.

Quilting charges are figured "per square inch" of your quilt top. Multiple the width of your quilt top by the length in inches to find the total SI or square inches of your quilt top. Then multiply that by .002 to obtain the pinning charge. Choose the type of quilting you want and multiply SI by that amount. Add those two amounts to find the approximate labor charge. Thread is additional and varies with density of quilting and thread choice.

Additional charges may be incurred if your quilt top and/or backing requires squaring up or pressing.

We prefer to do overall quilting and have many beautiful patterns from which to choose. I (Cheri) quilt on a Classic Plus Gammill with a Statler Stitcher computer program. Gina helps me out when I have more than a month's worth of quilts to do. Gina quilts with the same program as I though on an Gammill Optimum.

I will, on occasion, take a custom quilt to do. Custom quilts take more time and I prefer not to have a deadline for completion.

We are both meticulous about our quilting and your quilt tops and strive to exceed your expectations!
