Marsha will teach how to draft several star variations, lead students through planning and color placement, and show methods of piecing the design quickly and accurately on the sewing machine. In the tradition of the great wholecloth quilts, transform a solid piece of fabric into a work of beauty using the graceful Ivy Wreath or Holly design created especially for this class. Focus on refined free-motion techniques using the basic elements of Heirloom Machine Quilting: curvilinear motifs, grids, and stippling. Class includes information on essential supplies, machine set-up, marking, basting, navigating the design, plus time to begin stitching this beautiful project. This is a full day class and is limited to 16 students. You have a choice of an ivy or holly pattern.

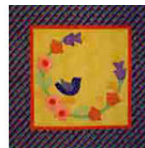

Learn about the latest innovations in marking tools, how you can change the size of designs, turn block designs into multi-sized borders and create continuous line designs. Joanie makes this fun and creative while impressing the importance that marking will bring to your machine quilting experience. This is a half day lecture/demo with no class limit.

Birdie in a Garden Wreath Invisible Machine Applique



Learn invisible appliqué by machine using this original pattern (or kit) based on traditional Folk Art shapes. First, discover a hassle-free preparation method for turned edge appliqué using heat resistant template plastic. (No messy glue or paper to remove!) Next, learn to attach the shapes with invisible appliqué by machine. This preparation method can be used for traditional hand appliqué or decorative edge finishing techniques by hand or machine, all will be demonstrated. This is a full day class and is limited to 16 students. Kit is available for \$18 that includes pattern and fabric or pattern only (\$9)

Hand Piecing 101

Start at the very beginning with Hand Piecing Basics in this class for all ages. Using "Quilting with Laura: Quilts Inspired by the Little House on the Prairie Series" as a workbook, students start with how to make hand piecing templates, move to marking and cutting fabric, and work their way through block construction. Corn and Beans is the pattern of the day! The book contains 13 other patterns to grow with. Children ages 8-14 may attend if accompanied by an adult. A perfect mother daughter/granddaughter class! Book is required. Class is limited to 20 students. Children that participate are included in the total.

Prairie Lilies Scrap Quilt



JOYOUS colors combine to create Prairie Lilies, constructed in Linda's two for one technique. Piecing in this method creates cutaways that are ready to go into a bonus quilt, so you are actually making two quilts at the same time. Make use of every bit of fabric. It is such fun! Students start with how to choose and combine fabrics for a quilt, giving valuable fabric selection skills that can apply to your future quilting. This is followed with Linda's two-for-one piecing method, then adorn with applique, utilizing a very nifty stem technique. In addition to the Prairie Lilies quilt, students will also be making a bonus quilt out of the cutaways. Limit 20 students.
